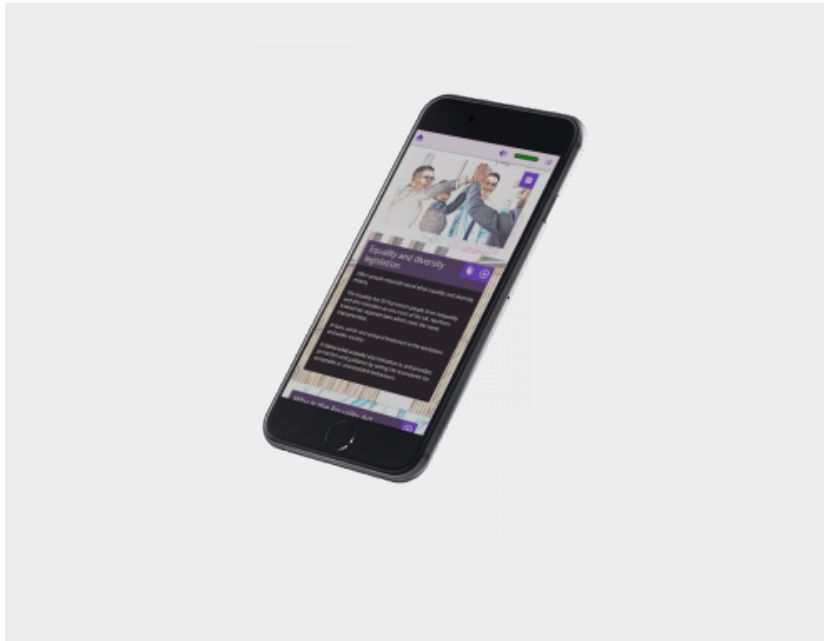


Introduction to the Equality Act 2010
