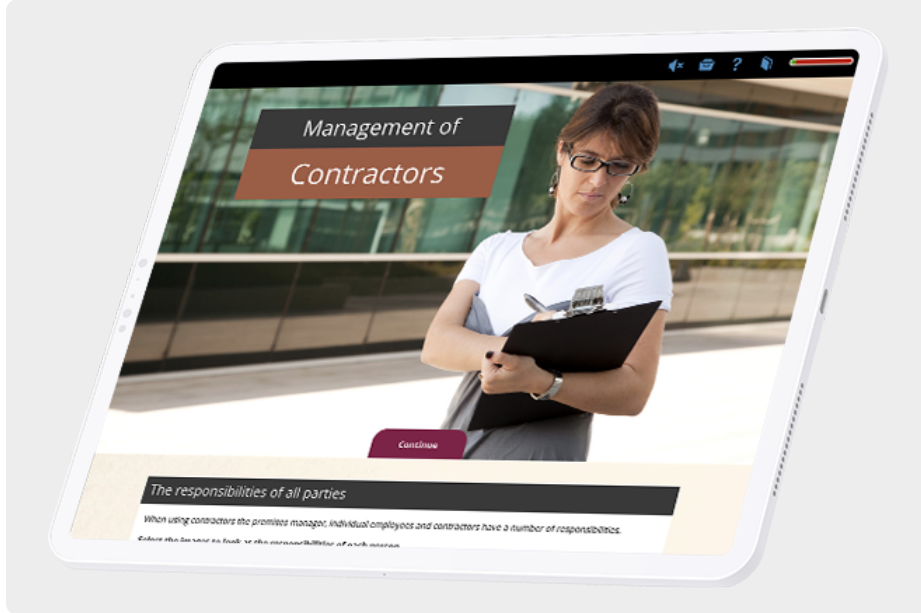


Contractor Management
