Course Overview

RIDDOR (Reporting of Injuries, Diseases and Dangerous Occurrences Regulations 2013) is a piece of legislation covering the legal obligation to report serious accidents, near misses and illnesses occurring through work. It can sometimes be difficult to decide if an incident "counts" under RIDDOR, and what does and does not need to be reported.
